

Delegate Application for 2010 ENA National General Assembly

Dear Georgia ENA Member,

Opportunities to represent the Georgia ENA as a delegate to the National General Assembly are open to all current national ENA members that hold current Georgia professional licensure who wish to apply. **The General Assembly will be held on September 22nd and 23rd, 2010 and will be followed by the Scientific Assembly from September 23rd - 25th, 2010 in San Antonio, Texas.**

Delegates represent the membership of each state in ENA. Participation in state and local ENA activities is very important. Therefore, first consideration for delegate selection will be for ENA members with at least 4 points in the attendance section. The selection process is based upon an accumulative point system outlined in the delegate form. Applicants are sorted from the highest to the lowest grand total points. Please complete the entire form since all sections will count toward the grand total of points. **We encourage all members to apply even if you think you do not have enough points.**

Applications must be received by July 9th, 2010. All applications received after this deadline will be accepted, but placed at the end of the list, regardless of point value. National ENA will notify Georgia of the total number of delegates and alternates assigned to our state during the summer months. When this total is known, applicants will be selected according to their position on the list.

Delegates are required to attend the entire General Assembly meeting on September 22nd and 23rd, 2010 in San Antonio, Texas. Attendance at Scientific Assembly is encouraged but not required. Financial assistance for the delegates from Georgia to the ENA General Assembly will be finalized at the August meeting in Macon. ***The GA ENA Board reserves the right to determine the amount and method of reimbursement according to the current financial status of the treasury.***

You will be notified by e-mail by July 16th, 2010 if you have been chosen as either a delegate or alternate. You must send a reply e-mail to confirm your acceptance as a delegate. Potential delegates and alternates are notified of their position and selection to serve by the Georgia ENA State Council President. Delegates will be required to participate in delegate education as provided by the ENA. This education will be presented as Online Delegate Training sessions. Each delegate will be required to attend one of the following Online Delegate Training sessions: **Wednesday, July 28, 2010, 3pm Central Time; Saturday, August 14, 2010, 10 am Central Time; or Thursday, September 9, 2010, 6pm Central Time. In addition to the Online Training session, attendance is required at the delegate preparation meeting at on August 28th, 2010 at 12n in Macon, Georgia.** Any vacancies in the Georgia delegation may be filled at this meeting. It is strongly advised that those persons applying for delegate status do so with the intent to serve if selected.

2. Attach copies of all certification cards. Credit will not be given without proof of current GA licensure, ENA membership and all certification cards.
3. Memberships that expire prior to the National General Assembly must be renewed, with proof of renewal sent to the Georgia State Council President prior to the National meeting.
4. Signed and completed forms with copies of current membership and certification cards must be received no later than July 9th, 2010. Forms and verification of certifications and membership must be mailed or emailed.
